

## **Philosophical Perspectives 1**

This course introduces the major methodologies of philosophy in the analytic tradition and analyzes the status they confer on typical philosophical methods. The methodologies we will discuss are trans-empirical philosophy, common sense philosophy, ordinary language philosophy, ideal language philosophy, pragmatism, feminist philosophy, naturalized philosophy, and the Canberra plan; some of the methods we will discuss are the use of reflective equilibria, thought experiments, language analysis, formal proofs, and the use of results from the sciences.
